COLOUR

Rosewood

NOSE

Dried fruits ripen, then soften. Vanilla accompanies green apple hand in hand. Ginger, nutmeg and cinnamon create an ensemble in the background, with strong notes of polished oak and a depth of resinous, juicy oranges.

PALATE

The palate opens rich in wood spices, slowly showing all their viscosity. Wood smoke flits in and out.

FINISH

The heavier raisin and sultana flavours take over, meandering to a long full finish.

Spanish Sunset

NOSE

Raisin, dates and figs dominate whilst sultana and toffee apples add texture and depth. The weight of flavour from the raisins is dark and rich with great viscosity. Dry ginger and soft cinnamon hint at the edges. Dark chocolate is majestic, vanilla sweetness lingers in the background.

PALATE

Heavy and sumptuous. A rich fruit cake of raisin, dates and figs, appples, sultanas, orange then ginger, nutmeg, cinnamon and hints of clove. Oak notes are like velvet, soft and chic.

FINISH

Silky smooth with a long and full finish.

COLOUR Blood Orange

NOSE

Fresh zest of orange and citrus fruits. A slight waxy note fades to fresh green apples. Robust notes of chocolate, thick fudge, boiled sweets, aniseed and caramel toffees with subtle white chocolate truffles. Fresh bananas and sweet oak arrives last.

PALATE

Initial light citrus zest with new oak gives way to the succulent sweetness of lemon and orange. Raisin, sultana, and apple, with a hint of cinnamon and giner, are subtle.

FINISH

Boiled sweets add balance to a glimpse of toasted oak to give a medium and soft finish.

NOSE

Soft notes of opulent vanilla and raisin give way to a sweet ensemble of apple, lemon, and orange. All balanced by a spicy quartet of root ginger, cinnamon, nutmeg, and clove.

PALATE

This spicy quartet are unwavering. Oak resonates, timeless, polished and rich. Vanilla and chocolate lead the finale along with a light citrus zest.

DECADE III

In the 1980s Roger Moore's playfulness gave way to a different tone with the arrival of Timothy Dalton as the next Bond. Dalton's brooding depth revealed new levels of the character. He fulfilled his duties heroically, his burden willingly shouldered. The packaging design features a logo concept art from Octopussy (1983), an A.T.A.C Operations area sketch and storyboard sequence for the film For Your Eyes Only (1981).

DECADE V

Leaving the 90s behind, Daniel Craig embodies the Bond of the noughties. The setting, ingredients, character and dedication to craft combine to deliver an utterly compelling result. The packaging design features a dramatic car sequence from Casino Royale (2006), and a digitally sketched rooftop chase in Quantum Of Solace (2008).

COLOUR

Suisse (Swiss) gold

NOSE

Fresh and vibrant notes of lemon and lime, a sprinkle of sherbet, leading into a sweet vanilla and coconut, with a hint of dried fig and raisin.

PALATE

Orange zest and fizzy sherbet with a lemon freshness, gentle oak and subtle ginger spice, leading into a deep dark chocolate, figs and baked apple tart with a honey drizzle.

FINISH

Sweet and long with complexed layers.

Speyside is a small part of the Highland region, located around the river Spey in the northeast of Scotland. Although Speyside is very small, no other region contains more operating distilleries.



Speyside Malts are very rich and complex whiskies with notes of fruits, honey, toffee and chocolate.

LOWLANDS

The Lowland region lies south of an imaginary line between Greenock and Dundee. From more than 200 distilleries in the late 19th century, nowadays only a handful are still operating.



Lowland Malts are generally lighter in body and flavour than their counterparts from other regions. They tend to be gentle and subtle, fragrant with herbal and grassy flavours and usually have a relatively dry finish. Since they are not, or only slightly, peated they are an excellent choice for beginners.
